2021 Code Table Amendments for Electronic Cargo Manifest (“EMAN”) and Cargo Manifest Data Capacity Enhancement

The Census and Statistics Department ("C&SD") has announced that the amendments to the code table for EMAN in 2021 will take effect on 1 January 2021. The amendments include updates to some Port/Place (Location) Codes and IATA Codes.

To support these amendments, Tradelink has developed upgrade to our LogiNet Deluxe Software.

For customers using LogiNet Deluxe Software:

- A Smart Upgrade Directive will be delivered to the inbox of your LogiNet Deluxe Software.
- Please execute the Smart Upgrade according to the instruction the first time you login after 31 December, 2020.

For customers using import flat file for EMAN submissions:

- Please update the code settings for their own systems. Failure to do so may result in application errors.

Also we would like to draw EMAN customers' attention that with effect from 1 January 2021, C&SD will increase the limit on the number of records as below:

- Increase maximum number of consignments from 9,999 to 30,000 per master level
- Increase maximum number of consignments from 10,000 to 30,000 per manifest
- Increase maximum number of cargo items from 20,000 to 30,000 per manifest
